Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) tests are computer-based assessments that measure a student's academic achievement in math, reading, language usage, and science, (Only math & reading for K-1) helping teachers, parents, and students understand a student's proficiency and growth. MAP tests are administered 3 times during the school year.
